Key Stages 2 and 3 Whether you are following the Newcastle Diocesan Education Board RE specifications for Church Schools, or your local SACRE specification, we can offer support for the following key themes: Christian Festivals and special days; the Church – buildings and communities; the Bible; Worship; the Eucharist; Prayer; and Rites of Passage.

Sessions include both interactive teaching and opportunities for pupils to engage in a variety of activities, including cross-curricular links with Art and DT.

We are also able to offer **Spirituality Days** (and half-days) for Key Stage 3 pupils. The days will engage pupils in an active exploration of the spiritual dimension of human life.

Key Stages 4 and 5 We can support your work in teaching Christianity at GCSE. We can also support students' learning in the areas of Christianity, Ethics, and Philosophy of Religion at AS and A2 levels.
